At the review of national emissions inventories at COP30, a key global priority was the alignment of a just transition mechanism in driving towards Long-Term Low Emissions Development Strategies (“LT-LEDS”) under the Paris Agreement. Unlike the past century, this signals a decisive shift in global climate governance, one that places developing countries, particularly Africa and the Caribbean region, at the forefront of energy transition. This evolution begs the urgent need for African and Caribbean energy leaders, institutions, and stakeholders to come together, now more than ever, to present a united front in promulgating just energy transition in the African and Caribbean region.

In addressing this fundamental challenge that confronts the African and Caribbean region, the International Center for Energy, within the context of the Gender Action Plan adopted by the United Nations Women at COP 30, has launched Jet for Africa (“Jet4Africa”) which is being championed by the Women in Energy and Finance (“WIEF”) with the following objectives;

- *To support, promote and commit to a just and equitable energy transition for Africa and the Caribbean Region, as championed by the International Center for Energy, recognizing the challenges within the Global South and advancing sustainable development and climate equity for its people, particularly women and children;*
- *To foster inclusive leadership across the energy and finance ecosystem, ensuring that diverse stakeholders, particularly African Women, lead in the Continent’s energy transition discourse;*
- *To encourage transformation of global financial institutions towards an Afro-Caribbean centric financial model while corporations and private sector organizations play an active role in financing and facilitating finance towards climate solutions.*

Given the disproportionate impact of energy poverty and climate vulnerability on women and children, the time has come for governments, institutions, the private sector, and citizens to coalesce around a shared commitment to a just energy transition. As the government cannot do it alone, the time has come for an all stakeholder coordinated action, aligned capital, and collective responsibility, in order to advance the objectives of the Paris Agreement and the aspirations of the International Centre for Energy through Jet4Africa. With the hope that we can count on your support, we hereby invite your kind endorsement and commitment to building a truly just and equitable society for mankind.
